Summer programming was correspondingly reviewed. The Events teams discussed both Adult and Children programming. They would like to start drop-in Kickball and Cornhole tournaments. Along with adding some options for disc golf, senior events, kids summer camps, and concerts. The Events team is always looking for partners and business connections to help sponsor and host events.

The committee discussed ideas for potential future programming. They would like to see Flag football, a Soap Box Derby, a BBQ Festival, Blues Festival, and many different options for Disc Golf. They would like to see a verity of kids and senior specific programming along with different skill levels of programming.
