New Paver Project Design Options

The committee still has options for engraving and material used so further discussions can happen. The committee brought up the following issues:

- The max height of the material used should be ½ an inch and the min height should be ¼ an inch. Will flagstone stick out and will it be durable?
- Paint as an option to use on the engraving to make it stick out
- Want to make sure the material we use is easy to 'pop out' so installation is easy
- The design is still important to fit with the scenery up here have no border, use moss, allow natural impediments
- Donation Paver Program Discussion
 - Level of donations would entice more people. Have a bronze, silver or gold level of donation. More research is needed to find out how much people will spend.
 - Figure out exactly where money is going
 - When someone buys one what happens next? (Scott)
 - When do we install
