The Five-Step Check-Up Process

Step One:

Call the SCORE Denver office and tell us you are interested. A Check-Up Team Leader will call to schedule a meeting with you.

Step Two:

Meet with the Team Leader to discuss the details and confirm that the Check-Up process is right for you.

Step Three:

SCORE Counselors will conduct the checkup:

- a. First meeting collect information through discussion and completing a questionnaire.
- b. Review of your financial information, business plans and other operating business documents.
- c. Series of meetings with different Team Members evaluating different business segments.
- d. Comparison of your organization to others in your industry segment.

Step Four:

Receive the SCORE review; get answers about your business strengths and weaknesses, and how your management practices compare. Confirm agreement on the findings.

Step Five:

Your SCORE Team will schedule an action-planning meeting to present to you a package of recommended action steps to implement.

Following this will be ongoing meetings to mentor your implementation of the action steps and help with any necessary issue alignment.

How much time will this take me away from my business?

The SCORE Teams will review your entire business in addition to your financials. They will focus on developing pragmatic action steps that will be designed to improve your company's efficiency and profitability for a very reasonable workshop registration fee.
