### **Paying for Student Art**

Student artists could be paid a few hundred dollars or more for their work, depending on the art. More expensive art could also be purchased. Donated art would always be appreciated. Depending on the success of placing art in Leslie's Garden, we would be willing to consider providing additional funding for additional art if needed and desired.

### **Implementation and Management**

We are open to how the Town of Dillon and the Garden Committee implement and manage the selection and placement of the art. A competition or committee could be used to select the art and decide its placement in Leslie's Garden.
