Supporting Information:

The Dillon Town Core Master Plan states wayfinding is a town core goal.

- -Wayfinding is needed for revitalization of the town core
- -Consistency throughout all town signage
- -Increase walkability and multi modal transportation in town core.

Existing vs. Proposed:

- -Not cohesive making them less effective
- -Car centric, not made for pedestrians
- -Not enough, people don't necessarily know they are in Dillon
- -Understanding of where amenities are located
- -More engaging for pedestrians. Marina to Town Park path
- -Promotes walkability when people know where they are going
