

Recall Petition Information - Number of Signatures

The recall petition process is determined by Town Code and the Colorado State Municipal Election Code.

The number of signatures each current Town Council member would need to be recalled is determined by 25% of the total votes cast for the position from the election when they were elected (divided by the number of seats open for the position in that election). These numbers are as follows:

Dana Christiansen	April 5, 2022	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election on April 5, 2022)
Renee Imamura	April 5, 2022	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election on April 5, 2022)
Kyle Hendricks	April 2, 2024	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election, April 2, 2024 election was canceled, candidate was elected)
Robin Tuyn	April 2, 2024	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election on April 5, 2022, April 2, 2024 election was canceled, candidate was elected
John Woods	April 2, 2024	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election on April 5, 2022, April 2, 2024 election was canceled, candidate was elected)
Oliver Luck	May 28, 2024	17 signatures needed on recall petition (201 votes cast at last municipal election on April 5, 2022, candidate was appointed to fill a vacancy)
